Application Deadline	For the following winter semester (Oct - Feb): May 15th For the following summer semester (Mar - Jul): November 15th
Selection of Courses	English Lectures and Summer Schools: Please find the English courses in our course overview. German Beginners/Advanced Course (each 2 ECTS credits) and Intercultural Training for Incomings (1 ECTS credit) are mandatory and part of the Learning Agreement. HBC offers 2 clusters of inter-disciplinary English courses (30 ECTS for each cluster) for Incoming students. Please find more information in this link.
Visa	Students from non-EU countries need a visa before entering Germany. All necessary papers will be issued in time by HBC and sent to the students. Please beaware that all students need to open a blocked account for the visa! For more information about student visa, please visit this page:

ResidencePermit	Students who can enter Germany for 3 months without a visa are obliged to apply for residence permit during orientation program at HBC. The costs will be approx. 100€. The following documents are needed: • Passport • A current biometric photo • Proof of health insurance • Tenancy agreement • Enrollment paper
	 Important: Proof that student has a sufficient means of 934€ per month. This can be proven by: Scholarship plus funds on an account if the scholarship is below 934€ 934€ on a locked German account (can be done during orientation program) A commitment by the parents or a legal guardian
Health Insurance	Statutory health insurance is compulsory for all students in Germany. Our application includes a membership declaration of a well-known insurance (AOK) that is accepted by HBC. Health insurance from abroad, especially travel insurance cannot be considered. The approx.

costs per month are 110€.

Orientation Program	HBC's International Office runs an orientation program for exchange students one week before the semester starts.
	The orientation program is mandatory for all exchange students.
Mentoring Program	Incoming students will be assigned a HBC student as their mentor. The mentors will assist the incoming students to integrate in the campus life at HBC.

	Winter semester: October 7, 2025 - February 1, 2025 Examination period: February 2025
Transcript of Records	6 weeks after the end of the semester, HBC's International Office will send a scanned version by E-mail to the International Office of the partner university.
ECTS and Grading System	ECTS stands for <u>European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System</u> is a common European grading framework designed on the purpose of facilitating the academic exchange among EU countries. Each ECTS credit generally requires around 30 hours of work. A standard full year of study workload is equivalent to 60 ECTS credits.
	The scale of German grading system is as follow: 1 – 1.5 Very good / 1.6 – 2.5 Good / 2.6 – 3.5 Satisfactory / 3.6 – 4.0 Sufficient Below 4.0 Fail
Tuition	No fees are charged for exchange students from HBC's partner universities. Semester contribution to Student Services: 92€/semester
Scholarship for non-EU students	Baden-Wuerttemberg-STIFTUNG offers scholarships (up to 700 €/month for 3-4 months)to our non-European partners. Exchange students applying for the Baden- Wuerttemberg-SCHOLARSHIP are to be nominated by the coordinator of the home university via e-mail with an internal ranking to HBC's International Office: incomings@hochschule-bc.de

Scholarship for students from IIP@HBC partner universities	Students from partner universities in our IIP@HBC Project are eligible to apply for the IIP@HBC Scholarship for up to 860€ for 4 months and travel support. The nominated students can submit a motivational letter when they fill in the HBC online application portal as part of the exchange application process.
